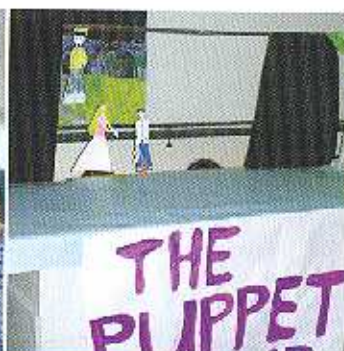

Campus

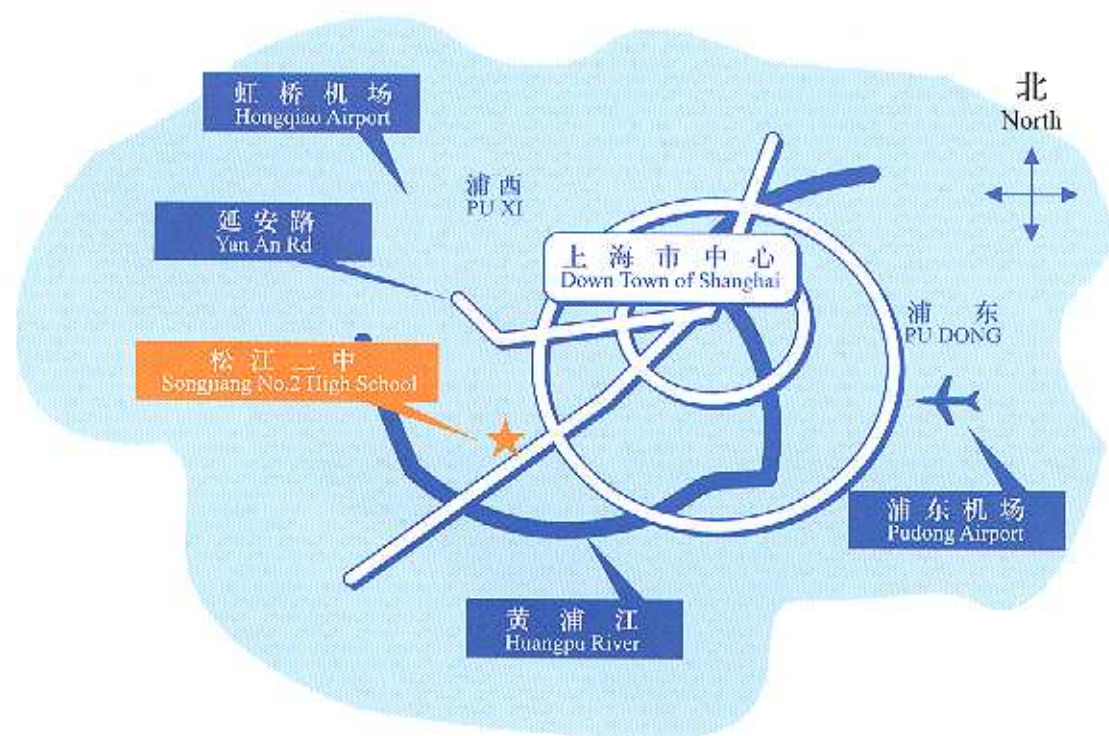
The Shanghai Songjiang No. 2 High School is a prestigious institute of education with over a century of illustrious history. It enjoys an elite reputation. It is a prestigious institute of education steeped in rich cultural heritage with a history spanning more than a century. It is the endeavor of faculty and staff at Songjiang No.2 High School to provide a strong foundation for the continued intellectual, physical, moral, and social development of its students; to foster responsible behavior; to nurture independence and creativeness of thought, and to provide support and guidance to students as their journey along their individual pathways to success.



Location

Songjiang, which is the birthplace of Shanghai's history and culture, lies in the southwest section of Shanghai. Long before Shanghai became prosperous, Songjiang was the political, economic, and cultural center of Shanghai. It became a place on the southern side of the Yangtze River well known for its fabulous food and plentiful resources.

A new Songjiang city now is under construction. The northern area displays a definite European style while the southern area features buildings follow the design of the Ming and Qing Dynasties. The Songjiang University Town, which has become the pride of Songjiang, brings together over ten famous universities. Transportation in and around Songjiang is most convenient. Within Songjiang, city buses ply the routes of all major roads as well as the side streets. It is only a thirty-minute drive from the campus to the Shanghai city center, while the highway connecting Shanghai and Hangzhou runs through Songjiang. The Hongqiao and Pudong international airports are conveniently close.



Facilities

The library, housed in a 1920s style building, offers the most modern and multi-functional services with all types of researching and learning materials. It is well stocked with books for educational as well as for leisure reading. In addition, various newspapers, journals, and magazines, from home and abroad, are available to students and faculty members.

In contrast to the library, the modern style of the Science Building reflects the inner sanctum of advanced science equipment, with which the teachers encourage the students to engage in independent experiments and projects. The computer rooms are equipped with updated computers, which allow the students to gain access to the Internet for information. A newly built office building anchors the campus.

The school also features complete and up-to-date sports facilities. The recently built gymnasium can be used not only for various ball games but also for physical training to satisfy different educational demands.

A standard plastic running track, imported from Germany, and a football field stand in the middle of the ground. On the southern edge of the ground lie spacious areas for tennis, basketball, and volleyball. The indoor swimming pool is an ideal place for students and teachers to exercise and to spend their leisure time.

Campus

Fenghua High School founded in 1947, grew out of Xingci Middle School, which was set up by the famous Chinese contemporary Buddhist monk Xingci. Now Fenghua High School is a key school providing high quality education in Shanghai. It is a beautiful school with modern education equipment.

With its teaching aim: 'Learn to conduct yourself. Learn to seek knowledge. Let your life radiate vigor', our school implements the policy of education for the future, and holds firmly to the concept, that is, high qualified teaching staff, high level management, modern teaching facilities and better education results.

Up till now, the school has been honored: gold medal for Health Promotion School by World Health Organization (WHO), a member of the project: Environment, Population and Development (EPD) organized by United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO). The school is the Advanced Unit of National Sports Hygiene. It's also the Shanghai Garden Unit, Behavioral Model School and Primary & Middle School's Educational Reform Base. Fenghua High School is one of the first Shanghai Bilingual Experimental Schools.

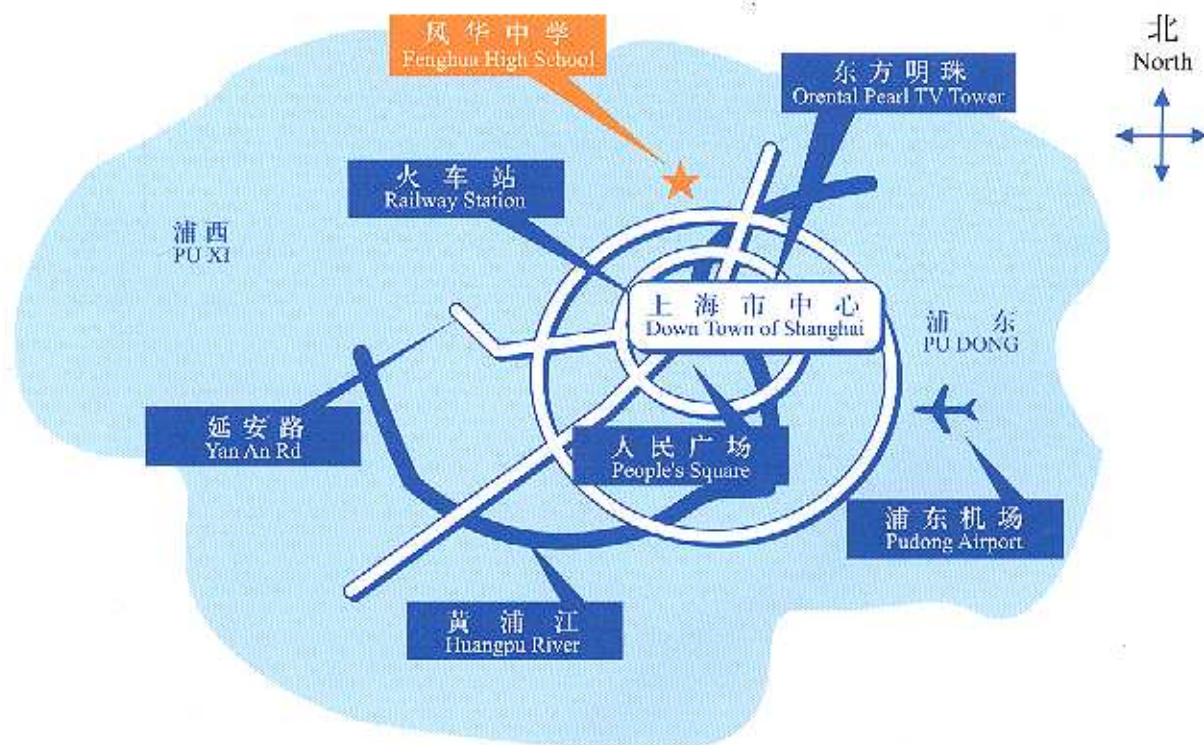
Location

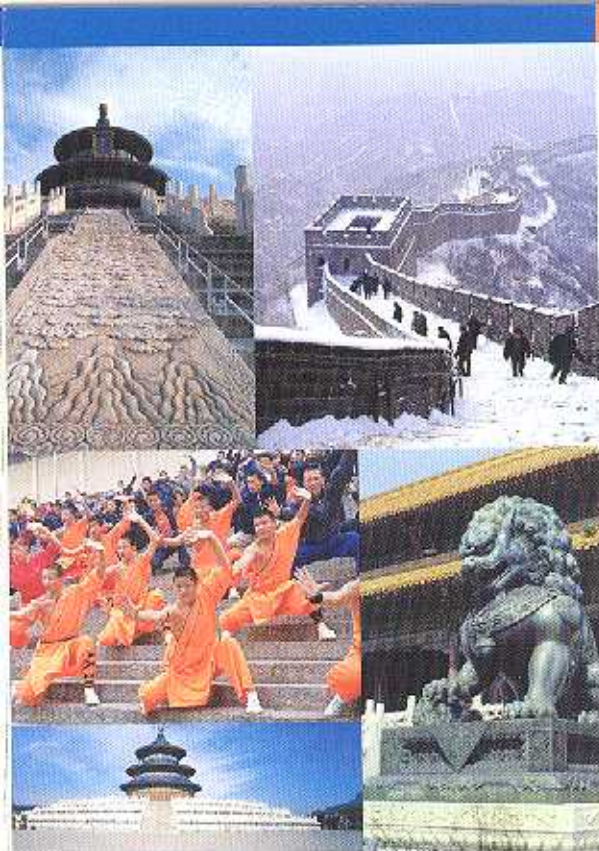
Fenghua High School is Located in the Northern of Shanghai downtown area.

Shanghai, also named "Hu" or "Shen" in short, is situated at 31°14' north latitude and 121°29' east longitude, and in middle of China's east coastline. It occupies a total area of 6,341 sq.km.(of which Pudong new Area occupies 523 sq.km.),with a total resident population of 16,000,000. It has a pleasant climate, with four distinct seasons. The average temperature is around 18°C and the annual precipitation is 1,240 mm.

Shanghai, an open city on the coast and famous historical and cultural city, is a gate to the Yangtze River delta. It is a municipality under the direct jurisdiction of the Central Government, the largest economic and trade center, a comprehensive industrial base and the leading port in China.

Shanghai is well known in the world not only for its prosperous cosmopolitan feature but also for its rich humanistic resources. In recent years, a number of modern buildings have been added to the city, such as the Oriental Pearl TV Tower, Shanghai Museum, Shanghai Library, Shanghai Stadium, Shanghai Grand Theatre, Shanghai Circus City, Shanghai City-Planning Exhibition Hall and Jin Mao Tower, Shanghai Science & Technology Museum. They have become new scenic sights in Shanghai. Colorful festivities, like Shanghai Tourism Festival and Shanghai China International Art Festival, have attracted and increasing number of tourists from home and overseas.





Facilities

Occupying 46 areas of land, the school campus has 24000 square meters' architecture acreage. All the architectural facilities were invested by the government and built according to the national architecture criterion. The school campus possesses of modern educational and leisure facilities such as DIS physics lab, library, electrical reading room, auditorium, basketball field and the other advanced facilities. Especially the school TV station, studio, robots lab and three psychological function rooms (including psychological consulting room, psychological testing room, debating room, psychological data room and the others customised classrooms) show more the academic characteristics of Fenghua High school.

The dormitory building accommodates two students to share a room. Each room is like a small apartment equipped with an air conditioner, telephone, single beds, desks, and bookshelves. Each room also has two toilets, two sinks and a shower.

Laundry service is also available upon request. The three-storey cafeteria is just a few minutes' walk from the dormitory.

■ Homestay

Each student can have a single room. And the family will provide air conditioner, toilet, hot water, telephone. Each family has healthy certificate and certificate of no record of committing crimes. They are pleased to help you and tell you more about China.

Courses will start from any Friday and last 14 or 21 days, from March to June, September to January every year.

There will be an additional cost \$ 69 for each increasing day.

With every 15 students, the cost for one teacher leading the program is free.

The estimated cost covers three meals a day (combination of Chinese and Western cuisines), living accommodation, language and culture courses, admission fees to museums and performances, field trips, travel cost to other cities, and accident insurance. It does not cover the cost of air travel to or from China.

Time used throughout China is Beijing standard time, which is 8 hours ahead of GMT

■ Measurement

China uses metric system for measurement.
A comparison between Chinese system and Anglo-American system:

LENGTH

- 1 km (1,000 m) = 2 li = 0.621 mile = 0.54 sea mile
- 1 m = 3 chi = 3.281 ft = 1.094 yard
- 1 li = 0.5 km = 0.311 mile = 0.27 sea mile
- 1 chi = 0.333 m = 1.094 ft
- 1 mile = 1.609 km = 3.219 li = 0.868 sea mile
- 1 ft = 0.305 m = 0.914 chi
- 1 sea mile = 1.852 km = 3.704 li = 1.15 mile

AREA

- 1 hectare = 15 mu = 2.47 acre
- 1 mu = 0.067 hectare = 0.164 acre
- 1 acre = 0.405 hectare = 6.07 mu

WEIGHT

- 1 kg = 2 jin = 2.205 pound

Chinese Meals

The meal usually begins with a set of at least four cold dishes, to be followed by the main courses of hot meat and vegetable dishes. Soup then will be served (unless in Guangdong style restaurants) to be followed by staple food ranging from rice and noodles to dumplings. If you wish to have your rice to go with other dishes, you should say so in good time, for most Chinese choose to have the staple food last or have none at all.

People in China tend to over-order food, for they will find it embarrassing if all the food is consumed. When you have had enough, just say so, or you will always be overeating!

- The water in Shanghai is not clean enough to drink directly. You should only drink boiled water or bottle water.
- Please keep your private goods safely. When you get off the bus, remember to take these goods with you.
- Please listen to the guide carefully before you visit any scenic site. If you lose your way, please make a phone call to the guide and wait for him/her where you first get off the bus.
- If you don't feel well, please tell your teacher as soon as possible.
- Please don't leave school alone or with your schoolmates. If you would like to take a walk or do some shopping, please tell the teacher first.
